

# **EY 1042 Cygnet Whopper Cotton Cloud Mobile**

#### **Materials**

#### **Cygnet Whopper Cotton 100g**

Shocking Pink (Col A) 1 Cobalt (Col B) 1 Azure (Col C) 1 Pesto (Col D) 1 Canary (Col E) 1 Tangerine (Col F) 1 Scarlet (Col G) 1 Zinc White (Col H) 3

Hooks Other materials

8mm hook 250g pack of polyester toy stuffing

#### **Abbreviations**

ch chain

cm centimetre

col colour

dc double crochet – insert hook into stitch, yrh and pull through stitch (2 loops on hook), yrh pull through both loops on hook

ins inches

tr treble crochet – yrh, insert hook into stitch, yrh and pull through stitch (3 loops on hook), yrh, pull through first two loops on hook (2 loops on hook), yrh and pull through two sts on hook

yrh wrap yarn around hook

dec dc two stitches together

### **CLOUD**

## With 8mm hook and Col H make a 6st magic ring

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st (12sts)

Rnd 2: \*dc in next st, 2 dc in next st; repeat from \* 5 more times (18 sts)

Rnd 3: \*dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st; repeat from \* 5 more times (24sts)

Rnd 4: \*dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st; repeat from \* 5 more times (30sts)

Rnd 5: \*dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc in next st; repeat from \* 5 more times (36sts)

Rnds 6-9: dc in each st

Rnd 10: \*dc in next 5 sts, 2 dc in next st; repeat from \* 2 more times, dc in next 24 sts (38sts) **Rnd 11:** \*dc in next 6 sts, 2 dc in next st; repeat from \* 2 more times, dc in next 24 sts (40sts)

Rnd 12: \*dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st; repeat from \* 4 more times, dc in next 24 sts (44sts)

Rnd 13: dc in next 9 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in next 29 sts (46sts)

Rnd 13: dc in next 10 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in next 5 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in next 29 sts (48sts)

Rnds 14-23: dc in each st

**Rnd 24:** dc in next 8 sts, dec, (dc in next two sts, dec) three times, dc in next 26 sts (40sts)

Rnd 26: dc in next 8 sts, dec, (dc in next st, dec) three times, dc in next 21 sts (36sts)

Rnd 27: dc in next 8 sts, (dec) four times, dc in next 20 sts (32sts)

Rnd 28: dc in next 8 sts, (2 dc in next st) six times, dc in next 18 sts (38sts)

Rnds 29-36: dc in each st

**Rnd 37:** dc in next 10 sts, (dec) four times, dc in next 20 sts (34sts)

Rnd 38: dc in next 8 sts, (dec) four times, dc in next 18 sts (30sts)

Rnds 39-42: dc in each st

Firmly stuff cloud, leaving approximately 50g of stuffing for the raindrops.

Rnd 43: \*dc in next 4 sts, dec; repeat from \* 5 more times (24sts)

Rnd 44: \*dc in next 3 sts, dec; repeat from \* 5 more times (18sts)

Add a little more stuffing if needed.

Rnd 45: \*dc in next 2 sts, dec; repeat from \* 5 more times (18sts)

Rnd 46: \*dc in next st, dec; repeat from \* 5 more times (12sts)

Rnd 43: dec 6 times (6sts).

Cut yarn and pull through remaining sts and secure tightly.

RAINDROPS (make one in each shade A to G)

With an 8mm hook make a 4 st magic ring

Rnd 1: 2dc in each st (8sts)

Rnd 2: \*dc in next st, 2dc in next st; repeat from \* 3 more times (12sts)

Rnds 3-4: dc in each st

Rnd 5: \*dc in next st, dec; repeat

from \* 3 more times (8sts)

Rnds 6-7: dc in each st

Add stuffing, rolling it into a ball shape and only stuffing the bottom half of the raindrop.

Rnd 8: dec in each st (4sts)

Thread yarn through remaining sts, pull tight and secure and cut leaving а long tail approximately 6-8 ins (15-20cm).

With a large yarn needle attach the raindrops to the bottom of the cloud, evenly spacing them, but using different yarn lengths to secure them.

You can hang the mobile using a mobile hanger (you can buy these on the internet or you can buy second hand mobiles and use the hanging mechanisms from these). Alternatively, you can attach to the wall using two picture hooks.
