



CY1 1 1 4 CYGNET DK  
LACY JUMPER

**Abbreviations:**

K: Knit	dec: decrease by working 2 sts together
P: Purl	skpo: slip 1 knit 1 pass slipped st over
St: stitch	yfwd: yarn forward
Tog: together	kfb: knit front back – increase by knitting into front and back of the st
K2tog: knit two sts together	

**Measurements:**

To fit bust size	34" (86cm)	36" (91cm)	38" (97cm)

**Materials:**

1 pair 3.75mm (UK10) knitting needles

1 pair 4mm (UK8) knitting needles

**Tension:**

On 4mm needles, 22sts and 30 rows to 10cm (4") over stocking stitch

**Pattern Panel A (worked flat over 19 sts)**

**Row 1 (RS)** K11, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K2

**Row 2** Purl to end, and for all subsequent even rows

**Row 3** K10, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K3

**Row 5** K9, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K4

**Row 7** K8, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K5

**Row 9** K7, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K6

**Row 11** K6, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K7

**Row 13** K5, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K8

**Row 15** K4, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K9

**Row 17** K3, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K10

**Row 19** K2, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K11

**Row 21** K2, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K11

**Row 23** K3, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K10

**Row 25** K4, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K9

**Row 27** K5, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K8

**Row 29** K6, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K7

**Row 31** K7, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K6

**Row 33** K8, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K5

**Row 35** K9, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K4

**Row 37** K10, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K3

**Row 39** K11, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K2

**Pattern Panel B (worked flat over 15 sts)**

**Row 1 (RS)** P5, skpo, yfwd, K1, yfwd, K2tog, P5

**Row 2** K5, P5, K5

**Row 3** P4, skpo, K1, yfwd, K1, yfwd, K1, K2tog, P4

**Row 4** K4, P7, K4

**Row 5** P3, skpo, K2, yfwd, K1, yfwd, K2, K2tog, P3

**Row 6** K3, P9, K3

**Row 7** P2, skpo, K3, yfwd, K1, yfwd, K3, K2tog, P2

**Row 8** K2, P11, K2

**Row 9** P2, K2tog, K3, yfwd, K1, yfwd, K3, K2tog, P2

**Row 10** rep row 8

**Row 11** P3, K2tog, K2, yfwd, K1, yfwd, K2, K2tog, P3

**Row 12** rep row 6

**Row 13** P4, K2tog, K1, yfwd, K1, yfwd, K1, K2tog, P4

**Row 14** rep row 4

**Row 15** P5, K5, P5

**Row 16** rep row 2

**Row 17** P6, K3, P6

**Row 18** K6, P3, K6

**Row 19** P7, K1, P7

**Row 20** K7, P1, K7

### **Pattern Panel C (worked flat over 19 sts)**

**Row 1 (RS)** K2, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K11

**Row 2** Purl to end, and for all subsequent even rows

**Row 3** K3, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K10

**Row 5** K4, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K9

**Row 7** K5, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K8

**Row 9** K6, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K7

**Row 11** K7, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K6

**Row 13** K8, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K5

**Row 15** K9, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K4

**Row 17** K10, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K3

**Row 19** K11, (K2tog, yfwd) 3 times, K2

**Row 21** K11, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K2

**Row 23** K10, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K3

**Row 25** K9, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K4

**Row 27** K8, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K5

**Row 29** K7, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K6

**Row 31** K6, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K7

**Row 33** K5, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K8

**Row 35** K4, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K9

**Row 37** K3, (skpo, yfwd) 3 times, K10

**Row 39** K2, (s5kpo, yfwd) 3 times, K11

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### **Front**

With smaller needles cast on 100 (106, 112)sts.

Work 8 rows in 1x1 rib.

Change to larger needles

**Row 1 (RS)** K10 (13, 16), work Pattern Panel A row 1, K4, work Pattern Panel B row 1, K4, work Pattern panel C row 1, knit to end.

This sets the position of the pattern panels.

**Row 2 and all subsequent WS**

**rows** Work all sts as they lie.

Rep steps 1-2, continuing to follow the pattern panels as set for 100 rows or until desired length is reached. Take note of final pattern panel row worked.

### **Shape Armholes**

Decrease 1 st at the beg and end of next two rows, continuing to work in pattern in between.

(96, 102, 108 sts)

Decrease 1 st at the beg and end of the next and following 5 alternate rows, continuing to work in pattern in between.

(84, 90, 96 sts)

Continue to work in pattern for a further 29 rows, working sts on WS rows as they lie. Do not cut yarn.

### **Shape Neck**

**Row 1** Work 34 (37, 40) sts, place remaining sts on a holder

**Row 2** Purl to end, and for all subsequent even rows

**Row 3** Work to last 5 sts, K2tog, k3

Repeat Row 3 until 26 (29, 32) sts remain

**Next Row** Continue to work in pattern for a further 9 rows. Do not cut yarn.

### Shape Left Shoulder

**Row 1 (RS)** Cast off 6 (7, 8) sts and every RS row until 8 sts rem, continuing to work in pattern for rem sts.

**Next Row** Work in pattern for 1 row. Cast Off all sts.

### Shape Front Neckline

Rejoin yarn and cast off 16 sts from holder 34 (37, 40). Work in pattern to end.

### Shape Right Shoulder

**Row 1 (WS)** Purl

**Row 2** K3, SKPO patt to end

Rep Rows 1-2 until 8 sts decreased on the neck edge, then work as for left side reversing all shapings.

### Back

With smaller needles cast on 100 (106, 112) sts. Work 8 rows in K1, P1 rib. Change to larger needles

Work in stocking st for 100 rows or until desired length is reached.

### Shape Armholes

Decrease 1 st at the beg and end of next two rows, continuing to work in pattern in between. (96, 102, 108 sts)

Decrease 1 st at the beg and end of the next and following 5 alternate rows, continuing to work in pattern in between. (84, 90, 96 sts)

Continue to work in pattern for a further 52 rows.

### Shape Shoulder and back of Neck

**Row 1** Cast off 6 (7, 8) sts, K18 (20, 22) sts, K2tog, K3, place rem 55 (58, 61) sts on a holder. (22, 24, 26 sts)

**Row 2** Purl

**Row 3** Cast off 6 (7, 8) sts, K to last 5 sts, K2tog, K3. (15, 16, 17 sts)

Rep Rows 2-3, one more time. (8, 8, 8 sts)

**Next Row** Work 1 row Cast Off all sts.

### Shape Other Shoulder

Rejoin yarn to remaining sts and K26, then place

these 26 sts on a holder, then K3, SKPO, K to end. (28, 32, 35 sts)

**Row 2 (WS)** Cast off 6 (7, 8) sts, P to end. (22, 24, 26 sts)

**Row 3** K3, skpo, K to end. (21, 23, 25 sts)  
14 - 15 - 16

Rep Rows 2-3, one more time, then rep Row 2, one more time. (8, 8, 8 sts)

**Next Row** Work 1 row Cast Off all sts.

### Sleeves (make two)

Cast on 48 (50, 52) stitches using smaller needles. Work 8 rows in 1x1 rib. Change to 4mm needles.

**Row 1 (RS)** K17 (18, 19), work Pattern Panel B row 1, K until 1 st rem, KFB, K1. (49, 51, 53 sts)

**Next Row** Work in pattern for 11 rows.

**Row 13 (RS)** K3, KFB, work in pattern to last 3 sts, KFB, K3. (51, 53, 55 sts)

**Rows 14-20** Work in pattern for 7 rows. Rep Rows 13-20, 11 more times. (73, 75, 77 sts)

Work in pattern until sleeve measures 15 1/2 in, (16 in, 16 1/2 in).

### **Start Upper Arm Shaping**

**Row 1** Cast off 4 (4, 5) sts, work in pattern to end, at the beginning of the next 2 rows. (65, 67, 67 sts)

**Row 3** K2, skpo twice, work in pattern to last 6 sts, K2tog twice, K2. (61, 63, 63 sts)

**Row 4** work WS row of pattern.

Rep Rows 3-4, one more time. (57, 59, 59 sts)

**Row 7** K3, skpo, work in pattern to last 5 sts, K2tog, K3. (55, 57, 57 sts)

**Row 8** work WS row of pattern.

Repeat Rows 7-8, 15 more times. (25, 27, 27 sts)

**Next Row** Work one row  
Cast Off all sts.

### **Finishing**

**Step 1** Lay front and back panels together, WS facing. Join right shoulder seam.

**Step 2** With RS facing and using smaller needles, pick up and knit 12 sts down front neck, 13 sts down front neck shaping, 16 (17, 18) sts across front, 13 sts down front neck shaping, 12 sts up front neck and 35 (37, 39) sts across back neck.

**Step 3** Work in 1x1 rib for 4 rows, then work in stocking stitch for 4 rows. Cast off all sts.

**Step 4** Join neckband and body panels at left shoulder seam.

**Step 5** Attach the sleeves to the main body, then sew up the sleeve and side seams.

Block gently according to ball band instructions.



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
