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## Needles

1 pair 4mm straight needles  
1 pair 5mm straight needles  
Cable needle

## Other

Stitch holders

## Tension

15 stitches over 22 rows  
working in stocking stitch.

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE THE CORRECT SIZING. If you tension square has less stitches, use a thinner needle, if more, use a thicker needle.

## Abbreviations

## Special Stitches

**C11b** slip next 6sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, k5, then knit across 6sts on cable needle

**K1b** knit into back of st

## FRONT

Using 4mm needles, cast on 83[91:99:107:115:123]sts, work in 1x1 Rib for 4cm, ending with a RS row.

Next Row: Rib to end inc 1 st at each end of row. 85[93:101:109:117:125]sts.

Change to 5mm needles and proceed as follows:

Row 1: k

Row 2: k1, p1, \*k1b, p1, rep from \* to last st, k1

Row 3 and 4: Rep rows 1 and 2 once more.

Row 5: k37[41:45:49:53:57], c11b, k37[41:45:49:53:57]

Row 6: k1, p1, \*k1b, p1, rep from \* to last st, k1

Row 7 to 18: Rep rows 1 & 2 another 6 times

Row 1 to 18 sets patt.

Continue until Front measures 19[18½:18:18½:17]ins 48[47:46:47:46:44]cm, ending with a WS row.

### Shape Armholes

Next 12 Rows: Dec 1 st each end of next and every foll alt row 6 times altogether. 73[81:89:97:105:113]sts

Cont without shaping until armholes measure 15[17:20:18:20:23]cm, ending with a WS row.

### Shape Neck

Next Row: Patt 28[31:34:40:43:46], turn, leave rem 45[50:55:57:62:67]sts on a stitch holder

\*Working on these 28[31:34:40:43:46]sts only proceed as follows:

Next Row: Patt

Next 13[13:13:17:17:17] Rows: Dec 1 st at neck edge of next and every foll alt row 7[7:7:9:9:9] times altogether.

21[24:27:31:34:37]sts

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 9[10:11:11:12:13]ins (23[25:28:28:30:33]cm), ending with a WS row. Cast off in rib.\*

With RS facing, working on rem 45[50:55:57:62:67]sts, slip 17[19:21:17:19:21]sts onto a stitch holder, rejoin yarn to rem 28[31:34:40:43:46]sts and patt to end.

Work from \* to \*.

## BACK

Using 4mm needles, cast on 83[91:99:107:115:123]sts and work 1x1 Rib for 4cm, ending with a RS row.

Next Row: Rib to end inc 1 st at each end of row. 85[93:101:109:117:125]sts

Change to 5mm needles and proceed as follows:

Row 1: k

Row 2: k1, p1, \*k1b, p1, rep from \*to last st, k1

Rows 1 and 2 set patt.

Keeping continuity of patt as set proceed until Back measures 19[18½:18:18½:17]ins (48[47:46:47:46:44]cm), ending with a WS row.

### Shape Armholes

Next 12 Rows: Dec 1 st each end of next and every foll alt row 6 times altogether. 73[81:89:97:105:113]sts.

Cont without shaping until armholes measure 23[25:28:28:30:33]cm, ending with a WS row.

### Shape Shoulders

Cast off 21[24:27:31:34:37]sts in rib, patt 30[32:34:34:36:38], cast off 21[24:27:31:34:37]sts in rib.

Leave centre 31[33:35:35:37:39]sts on a stitch holder.

## SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 4mm needles, cast on 41[43:47:49:51:55]sts and work in 1x1 rib for 4cm, ending with a RS row.

Next Row: Rib to end inc 1 st at each end of row. 43[45:49:51:53:57]sts.

Change to 5mm needles and proceed as follows:-

Row 1: k

Row 2: k1, p1, \*k1b, p1, rep from \* to last st, k1

Rows 1 and 2 set patt.

Keeping continuity of patt as set proceed as follows:

Next 107[119:115:131:125:140] Rows: Inc 1 st each end of 5<sup>th</sup> and every foll 6<sup>th</sup>[6<sup>th</sup>:5<sup>th</sup>:6<sup>th</sup>:5<sup>th</sup>:5<sup>th</sup>] row 18[20:23:22:25:28] times altogether, working inc sts in patt. 79[85:95:95:103:113]sts

Cont without shaping until Sleeve measures 17[17½:18:18½:19½]ins (43[44:46:47:48:50]cm), ending with WS row.

### Shape sleeve

Next 12 rows: Dec 1 st each end of next and every foll alt row 6 times altogether.

67[73:83:83:91:101]sts

Cast off 9[9:9:11:11:11]sts in rib at beg of next 6 rows. 13[19:29:17:25:35]sts

Cast off rem 13[19:29:17:25:35]sts in rib.

### Crew Neckband

Join right shoulder seam. With RS facing, using 4mm needles, pick up and knit 20[20:20:26:26:26]sts evenly along left side of neck, 17[19:21:17:19:21]sts left on a stitch holder at front of neck, 19[19:19:25:25:25]sts evenly

along right side of neck and  
31[33:35:35:37:39]sts left on  
stitch holder at back of neck.  
87[91:95:103:107:111]sts

Proceed as follows:

Commencing with 2<sup>nd</sup> row of 1x1  
rib work 7cm, ending with a WS  
row.

Cast off in rib.

### **Roll Neckband**

Join right shoulder seam. With RS  
facing, using 4mm needles, pick  
up and knit  
20[20:20:26:26:26]sts evenly  
along left side of neck,  
17[19:21:17:19:21]sts left on  
stitch holder at front of neck,  
19[19:19:25:25:25:25]sts evenly  
along right side of neck and  
31[33:35:35:37:39]sts left on a  
stitch holder at front of neck.  
87[91:95:103:107:111]sts.

Proceed as follows:

Commencing with 2<sup>nd</sup> row of st-st  
work 9 rows.

Cast off loosely knitways.

With RS facing, using 4mm  
needles, pick up and knit the  
same 87[91:95:103:107:111]sts  
around inside of neck and  
commencing with 2<sup>nd</sup> row of 1x1  
rib proceed as follows:

Next 9 Rows: Rib

Next 9 Rows: St-st

Cast off loosely purlways.

## **Making up**

### **CREW NECK**

Join left shoulder and neckband  
seams. Fold neckband in half  
onto WS and slip stitch loosely in  
position. Fold sleeves in half  
lengthways, then placing folds to  
shoulder seams, sew sleeves in  
position. Join side and sleeve  
seams.

### **ROLL NECK**

Join left shoulder and neckband  
seams, reversing seams for st-st  
rolls. Fold sleeves in half  
lengthways, then placing folds to  
shoulder seams, sew sleeves in  
position. Join side and sleeve  
seams.



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
