NeedlesButtonsTension1 pair of 5mm (UK 6/U S8)6 toggles15 sts over 28 rows in garter1 pair of 6mm (UK 4/US 10)stitch on 6mm needles

Pattern abbreviations

3	BRBC	sl 1 st to cn and hold to back, k2, p1 from cn
3	BLBC	SI 2 sts to cn and hold to front, p1, k2 from cn
4	IRBC	SI 2 sts to cn and hold to back, k2, p2 from cn
4	ILBC	SI 2 sts to cn and hold to front, p2, k2 from cn
4	IRC .	SI 2 sts to cn and hold to back, k2, k2 from cn
4	ILC	SI 2 sts to cn and hold to front, k2, k2 from cn

Pattern panel (worked over 20 sts)

Row 1: (RS) K2, p6, k4, p6, k2 Rows 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10: knit the knit stitches and purl the purl sts. Row 3: 3LBC, p4, 3RBC, 3LBC, p4, 3RBC

Row 5: p1, 4LBC, 4RBC, p2, 4LBC,

4RPC, p1

Row 7: p3, 4RC, p6, 4LC, p3

Row 9: p1, 4RBC, 4LBC, p2, 4RBC,

4LBC, p1

Row 11: 3RBC, p4, 3LBC, 3RBC,

p4, 3LBC

Row 12: p2, k6, p4, k6, p2



BACK

With 5mm needles cast on 82[90:98]sts

Row 1: K2, *p2, k2; rep from * to end

Row 2: P2, *k2, p2; rep from * to end

These two rows set 2x2 rib pattern. Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until measures 3 inches (8cm), ending on Row 2.

Main body

With 6mm needles:

Row 1: K7[11:11], *pm, work Row 1 of patt (20sts), pm, k4[4:8]*; rep from * to * once more, pm, work Row 1 of patt (20sts), pm, k to end

Row 2: K7[11:11], *sm, work Row 2 of patt (20sts), k4[4:8]*; rep from * to * once more, sm, work Row 2 of patt, k to end.

Continue in gs and continue working from pattern chart (sm on each row to keep your place) and repeat pattern as necessary. Work straight until back measures 17½ ins (44cm) ending with a ws row.

Armhole shaping

Next row: Cast off 6 sts at beg of next 2 rows. (70[78:86]sts)

Keeping patt correct, work straight until armholes measure 7½ ins (19cm), ending with a ws row.

Shoulder shaping

Next row: Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 4 rows, then 5[6:7]sts at beg of next 6 rows. Cast off rem 24[26:28]sts.

LEFT FRONT

Using 5mm needles cast on 34[38:42]sts and work 3 ins (8cm) in 2x2 rib, inc 1 st at beg of last row (ws). (35[39:43]sts)

Change to 6mm needles

Row 1: K7[11:11], pm, work Row 1 of patt (20sts), pm, k to end.

Row 2: k8[8:12], work Row 2 of patt (20sts), k to end.

Continue in gs and continue working from pattern chart (sm on each row to keep your place) and repeat pattern as necessary. Work straight until back easures

17½ ins (44cm) ending with a ws row.

Armhole shaping

Next row: Cast off 6 sts at beg, k and patt to end. (29[33:37]sts)

Keeping patt correct, work straight until armholes measures 7 rows less than back.

Neck shaping

Cast off 1[2:3]sts at beg of next row. Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 4 rows then once on following alt row. (23[26:29]sts)

Shoulder shaping

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next and foll alt row, then 5[6:7]sts at beg of every alt row twice.

Work 1 more row.
Cast off rem 5[6:7]sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 5mm needles cast on 34[38:42]sts and work 3 ins (8cm) in 2x2 rib, inc 1 st at beg of last row (ws). (35[39:43]sts)

Change to 6mm needles

Row 1: K8[8:12], pm, work Row 1 of patt (20sts), pm, k to end.

Row 2: k7[11:11], work Row 2 of patt (20sts), k to end.

Continue in gs and continue working from pattern chart (sm on each row to keep your place) and repeat pattern as necessary. Work straight until back measures 17½ ins (44cm) ending with a rs row.

Armhole shaping

Next row: Cast off 6 sts at beg, k and patt to end. (29[33:37]sts)

Keeping patt correct, work straight until armholes measures 7 rows less than back.

Neck shaping

Cast off 1[2:3]sts at beg of next row. Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 4 rows then once on following alt row. (23[26:29]sts)

Shoulder shaping

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next and foll alt row, then 5[6:7]sts at beg of every alt row twice.

Work 1 more row.

Cast off rem 5[6:7]sts.

SLEEVES (make 2)

With 5mm needles cast on 42[42:50]sts and work 3 ins (8cm) in 2x2 rib

Change to 6mm needles

Row 1: k11[11:15], pm, work Row 1 of patt (20sts), pm, k to end

Continue in gs and continue working from pattern chart (sm on each row to keep your place) work 19 rows, inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 9th[9th:16th] row until there are 62 sts.

Work 8[8:9] rows straight. Pm at each end of last row to mark end of sleeve seam. Work 10 rows straight.

Cast off.

HOOD (make 2 pieces)

With 6mm needles cast on 62 sts and work 4 rows in gs.

Dec 1 st at beg of next and every alt row until 52sts rem.

Knit 6 rows, pm at end of last row. Work 16[18:20]rows straight.

Next row: Cast off 4 sts, k to end. **Next row:** dec 2 sts at neck edge of next 5 rows.

Cast off.

Press all pattern pieces gently. Join shoulder seams and insert sleeves, lining up the centre of the

pattern with the shoulder seam and stitching in place, joining the last 10 rows of the sleeve to the 6 cast off stitches on the body. Sew sleeve and side seams using mattress stitch.

Sew back seam of the hood to the marker. Sew hood to neck edge starting and finishing level with front edge.

LEFT FRONT BAND

With 5mm needles and rs facing and starting at the top of the hood, pick up and knit 68sts evenly along side edge of hood, 122sts evenly along left front edge. (190sts)

Starting with Row 2 of 2x2 rib pattern, work 10 rows in 2x2 rib. Cast off in 2x2 rib.

RIGHT FRONT BAND

With 5mm needles and rs facing and starting at lower front edge, pick up and knit 122sts evenly along right front side and 68 sts evenly along side edge of hood, ending at the top of the hood. (190sts).

Work 5 rows in 2x2 rib as with left front band.

Buttonholes

Next row: Rib 6, *cast off 2sts, rib 20 (including st already on needle); rep from * 4 more times, cast off 2 sts, rib 6, continue in rib along side edge of hood. **Note:** work the st after the cast off stitches tight.

Next row: rib 8, sts along hood, rib 4, *turn and using thumb method and holding yarn taut, cast on 2 sts, with tip of left hand needle, pick up edge of loop from first bound off stitch and purl it together with the next st, rib 19; rep from * 4 more times, cast on 2 sts, rib 6.

Work a further 3 rows in 2x2 rib. Cast off in rib.

Join remaining seam of hood and ribbed band. Sew on toggles.
