<b>Double Moss Stitch Pattern</b>
<b>Row 1:</b> *p1, k1; repeat from * to end
<b>Row 2:</b> *p1, k1; repeat from * to end
<b>Row 3:</b> *k1, p1; repeat from * to end
<b>Row 4:</b> *k1, p1; repeat from * to end
<b>Tip:</b> To ensure you don't lose track of where you are in the moss stitch pattern, you can follow this rule: On the rs you will always knit into the back of a knit st and purl into the back of a purl. On the ws you will always purl into the back of a knit and knit into the back of a purl.

<b>Knit Ridge Pattern</b>
<b>Row 1:</b> knit
<b>Row 2:</b> purl
<b>Row 3:</b> knit
<b>Row 4:</b> knit
Repeat last 4 rows throughout sleeves.

## BACK

**With 4mm needles** cast on 60[68:74:78:84]sts

### Rib

**Row 1:** K1, \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end

**Row 2:** P1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end

These two rows set rib pattern. Work Rows 1 and 2 until measures 1½in (4cm)

### Main body

**With 4.5mm needles and working in double moss stitch:**

Work 10[10:12:14:14] rows without shaping.

**Next row:** Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4<sup>th</sup>[4<sup>th</sup>:6<sup>th</sup>:6<sup>th</sup>:8<sup>th</sup>] row until there are 68[72:78:82:88]sts.

Cont in patt working straight until back measures 7[8¼:8¾:8¾:9]ins (17.5[21:22:22:23]cm).

### Armhole shaping

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows.\*\*

**Next row:** k1, skpo, patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1

**Next row:** patt

Last two rows form raglan shaping.

Cont raglan shaping until 30 sts remain.

Cast off.

## FRONT

As back to \*\*.

Work an even number of rows of Raglan Shaping until 58 sts remain.

**Next row:** k1, skpo, patt across 21sts. Put remaining 34 sts on a stitch holder. (23 sts)

**Next row:** k2tog patt to end. (22 sts)

**Next row:** k1, skpo, patt to end. (21 sts)

**Next row:** patt to end (21 sts)

**Next row:** k1, skpo, patt to last 2 sts, k2tog. (19 sts)

**Next row:** patt to end (19 sts)

**Next row:** k1, skpo, patt to end (18 sts)

**Next row:** k2tog patt to end (17 sts)

**Next row:** k1, skpo, patt to end (16 sts)

**Next row:** patt to end (16 sts)

**Next row:** k1, skpo, patt to last 2 sts, k2tog. (14 sts)

**Next row:** patt to end (14 sts)

**Next row:** k1, skpo, patt to end (13 sts)

**Next row:** k2tog patt to end (12 sts)

**Next row:** k1, skpo, patt to end (11 sts)

**Next row:** patt to end (11 sts)

**Next row:** k1, skpo, patt to last 2 sts, k2tog (9 sts)

**Next row:** patt to end (9 sts)

**Next row:** k1, skpo, patt to end (8 sts)

**Next row:** k2tog patt to end (7 sts)

**Next row:** k1, skpo, patt to end (6 sts)

**Next row:** patt to end (6 sts)

**Next row:** k1, skpo, patt to last 2 sts, k2tog (4 sts)

**Next row:** patt to end (4 sts)

**Next row:** k1, skpo, patt to end (3 sts)

Cast off remaining 3 sts.

Rejoin yarn to stitches from stitch holder.

**Next row:** slip first 10 sts on to a st holder, k2tog, patt to end (23 sts)

**Next row:** patt to end (23 sts)

**Next row:** k2tog, patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (21 sts)

**Next row:** patt to end (21 sts)

**Next row:** patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (20 sts)

**Next row:** k2tog, patt to end (19 sts)

**Next row:** patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (18 sts)

**Next row:** patt to end (18 sts)

**Next row:** k2tog, patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (16 sts)

**Next row:** patt to end (16 sts)

**Next row:** patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (15 sts)

**Next row:** k2tog, patt to end (14 sts)

**Next row:** patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (13 sts)

**Next row:** patt to end (13 sts)

**Next row:** k2tog, patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (11 sts)

**Next row:** patt to end (11 sts)

**Next row:** patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (10 sts)

**Next row:** k2tog, patt to end (9 sts)

**Next row:** patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (8 sts)

**Next row:** patt to end (8 sts)

**Next row:** k2tog, patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (6 sts)

**Next row:** **Next row:** patt to end (6 sts)

**Next row:** patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (5 sts)

**Next row:** k2tog, patt to end (4 sts)

**Next row:** patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (3 sts)

Cast off remaining 3 sts.

## SLEEVES (make two)

**With 4mm needles** cast on 30[32:34:36:38]sts.

Work 1x1 rib until sleeve measures 1½in (4cm)

**Change to 4.5mm needles,** working in Knit ridge pattern, work straight for 10 rows

**Next row:** Keeping in patt, work inc row at next and foll 5<sup>th</sup> row until you have 48[52:58:60:66]sts.

Work a further 3[3:3:5:3] rows in patt.

### Raglan shaping

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next two rows.

**Next row:** k1, skpo, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1

**Next row:** patt

Repeat last two rows until 16sts remain. Cast off remaining 16 sts.

### COLLAR

Join all raglan seams.

With 4.5mm needles and right side of work facing, rejoin yarn and work across sts from front on holder as follows: k1, kfb, k to last 3 sts, kfb, k1 (12 sts)

Continue straight and in garter st for 1in (3cm), ending with a ws row.

**Next row:** k1, kfb, k to end

Continue straight in garter stitch until collar is long enough to fit up front neck edge, around back neck and down front ending on a ws row.

**Next row:** k2tog, knit to end (12 sts)

Continue straight for a further 3cm and cast off loosely.

### Making up

Join sleeve and side seams. Sew side edge of side the collar to neck edge, easing in the extra length at the shoulders and back neck. Sew cast off edge neatly behind sts picked up at centre front. Sew in loose ends.

### Button loop (optional)

Using a 4mm crochet hook, ch10 sts. Attach ch to side edge of front collar approx 5 rows up from beginning of collar and secure both ends to form a loop. Attach a button to the left of the collar to align with the button loop.
