## Materials

### Lace sleeve

Cygnat Pure Wool Superwash Everglade 2817	50g	9	9	10	10

### Needles

3.25mm (UK 10 – US 3) needles  
4mm (UK 8 – US 6) needles

### Other

Stitch markers  
1 button

### Tension

19sts over 26 rows in stocking stitch on 4mm needles

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE THE CORRECT SIZING. If your tension square has less stitches, use a thinner needle, if more, use a thicker needle.

## Abbreviations

### BACK

With 3.25mm needles cast on 90[96:102:108] sts.

Row 1: (k1, p1) to end

Row 2: (k1, p1) to end

Last two rows form rib pattern.

Continue in rib until Back measures 2ins (5cm) ending with a ws row.

Change to 4mm needles and continue in stst, inc 1 st at each end of 11<sup>th</sup> and every foll 8<sup>th</sup> row

until there are 104[110:116:122]sts.

Continue straight until Back measures 13ins (33cm) from cast on edge, ending with a ws row.

### Shape Armholes

Cast off 6 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row until there are

74[78:82:86]sts remaining, ending with a ws row.\*\*

### Shape neck

Next row: k37[39:41:43], turn and leave remaining sts on a stitch holder.

Continue working on these sts only and work straight until work measures 7[7½:8:8½]ins (18[19:20:21.5]cm) from beg of armhole, ending at the armhole edge.



### Shape Shoulder

**Next row:** cast off 8 sts at beginning of next and foll alt row and 9[10:11:12]sts at beg of foll alt row.

Work 1 row.  
Cast off.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to sts on stitch holder and work straight until work measures 7[7½:8:8½]ins (18[19:20:21.5]cm) from beg of armhole, working 1 more row than other side, ending at the armhole edge.

### Shape Shoulder

**Next row:** cast off 8 sts at beginning of next and foll alt row and 9[10:11:12]sts at beg of foll alt row.

Cast off.

### FRONT

Work as for Back up to \*\*.

Work straight until work measures 5[5½:6:6½]ins (13[14:15:16.5]cm) from beg of Armhole Shaping, ending with a ws row.

### Shape Neck

**Next row:** k33[34:35:36], turn leave remaining sts on a st holder.

Continue working on these sts, dec 1 st at neck edge on every row until 22[23:24:25]sts remain, ending at armhole edge.

### Shape Shoulder

**Next row:** cast off 8 sts at beginning of next and foll alt row and at the same time, dec 1 st at neck edge.

Work 1 row.  
Cast off.

With rs facing, slip first 8[10:12:14]sts from stitch holder onto a spare needle or another stitch holder and rejoin yarn to the remaining 33[34:35:36]sts and knit to the end of the row.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on every row until 22[23:24:25]sts remain, ending at armhole edge.

### Shape Shoulder

**Next row:** cast off 8 sts at beginning of next and foll alt row and at the same time, dec 1 st at neck edge.

Cast off.



### SLEEVES (make two)

**With 3.25mm needles and Superwash Everglade** cast on 58[60:64:66]sts.

Work 5 rows in rib.

**Inc row:** rib 4[2:2:2], \*m1, rib2; rep from \* to last 4[4:4:2] sts, m1, rib to end. (84[88:94:98]sts).

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:

**Row 1 (rs):** purl

**Row 2 (ws):** purl

**Row 3 (rs):** k1, \*yo, skpo; rep from \* to last st, k1

**Row 4:** purl

These 4 rows form Lace patt.

Continue in Lace patt until sleeve measures 5[5½:5½]ins (13[13:14:14]cm), ending on Row 1 of patt.

### Shape sleeve top

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows and then dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row until 30[34:36:40]sts remain.

**Next row:** p2[3:4:2], p2tog, \*p1, p2tog; rep from \* to last 2[2:3:3]sts, p to end. (21[24:26:28]sts).

**Next row:** p2[2:3:4], p2tog, \*p1, p2tog; rep from \* to last 2[2:3:4]sts, p to end.

Cast off.

### NECKBAND

Join shoulder seams. With rs facing and 3.25mm needles, join yarn to left side back neck opening and pick up and knit 19[20:21:22]sts from left back neck, k16 sts down left front neck, k8[10:12:14]sts from holder, k16 sts up right front neck, and 19[20:21:22]sts from right back neck. (78[82:86:90]sts).

Work 6 rows in rib.

Cast off in rib.

### Making up

Fold sleeves in half lengthways and line up fold with shoulder seam. Stitch in place, easing in to fit where necessary. Join sleeve and side seams. Make a button loop and attach at top left hand side of back opening and attach button to right hand side.
