



## SPIDER WEB



A free crochet pattern from  
Knitting Pretty Ireland

### MATERIALS

Yarn – for this pattern we have used a combination of Elian Elegance in black and Cygnet Glittery DK in red. Available from Knitting Pretty Ireland

1 x 5mm crochet hook

1 x Darning needle





## ABBREVIATIONS

C = chain

DC = double crochet

SL ST – slip stitch

**PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS PATTERN IS WRITTEN IN US TERMS**

1. Holding both strands of yarn together C6.
2. Make a circle by joining together with a SL ST through the first stitch nearest the knot.
3. DC into the middle of the circle all the way round. Join to the first DC with a SL ST. (pic 1).



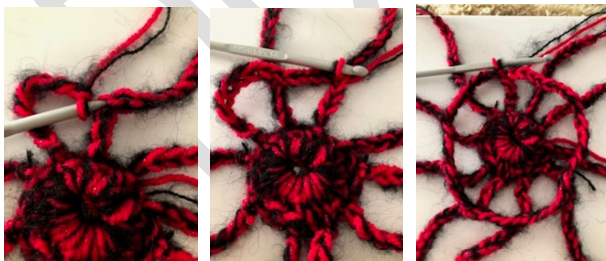

4. C16 (pic 2). Secure and cut the yarns
5. Re-attach yarns to the next but one stitch (pic 3) and C16. Secure and cut the yarns.
6. Continue to make chains of 16 into every alternate stitch round the circle until the second to last stitch (pic 4).
7. Re-attach the yarns as before and C8.

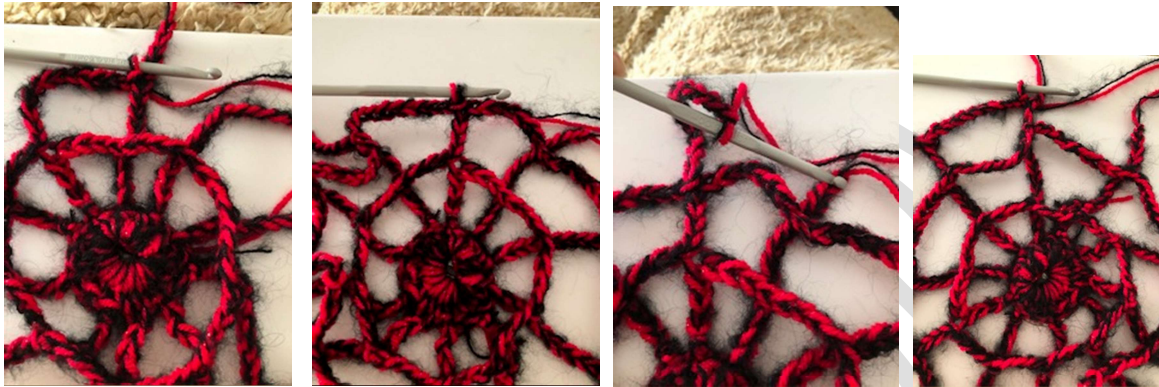

8. Count 4 stitches up from the bottom on the next chain of 16 and attach with a SL ST (pic 5).



9. C4 and attach with a SL ST to the next chain on the circle 4 stitches up from the bottom (pic 6). Continue until you have gone round the whole circle attaching the chains together and until you get back to the first chain of 8.

10. Count 4 stitches up from the bottom and join with a SL ST. You will have made your first round of the cobweb (pic 7).

11. C12. Count 4 stitches up from the cobweb round on the next chain and attach with a SL ST (pic 8).

12. C8. Attach with a SL ST to the next chain. Continue round the whole circle until you get back to the first chain of 12.

13. Count 4 stitches up and join with a SL ST. You will have made your second round of the cobweb (pic 9).

14. C14. Attach with a SL ST to the last stitch of the next chain (pic 10). C10.

15. Attach with a SL ST to the last stitch of the next chain. C10. Continue round the cobweb (pic 11) until you get back to the first chain of 14.

16. Count 4 stitches up the last chain and attach with a SL ST. Weave in all the ends.
