Materials

Cygnets Utopia DK Atlantic 534	100g	5	5	6	6	6	7	7
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Needles

1 pair of 3.25mm
1 pair of 4mm

Tension

18 stitches and 22 rows to
10cm (4in) over patt on 4mm
needles

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE THE CORRECT SIZING. If your tension square has less stitches, use a thinner needle, if more, use a thicker needle.

Special stitches

C6B: Cable 6 back – place next 3 sts onto a cable needle and place at back of work, K3 then K the 3 sts from cable needle.

C6F: Cable 6 forward – place next 3 sts onto a cable needle and place at front of work, K3 then K the 3 sts from cable needle.

Abbreviations

FRONT

With 3.25mm knitting needles cast on 110[116:122:128:134:140:146] sts
Work 19 rows in K1, P1 rib
Working in rib inc 1 st in every 8th to last end (124[130:138:144:150:158:164] sts)
Change to 4mm knitting needles and commence pattern.

Row 1: K16[19:23:26:29:33:36], P7, (K12, P10) x3, K12, P7, K16[19:23:26:29:33:36]

Row 2: P16[19:23:26:29:33:36],

K7, (P12, K10) x3, P12, K7, P16[19:23:26:29:33:36]

Rows 3 and 4: Repeat rows 1 and 2

Row 5: K16[19:23:26:29:33:36], P7, (C6B, C6F, P10) x3, C6B, C6F, P7, K16[19:23:26:29:33:36]

Row 6: As row 2

Rows 7 and 8: As rows 1 and 2
These 8 rows form the pattern.

Continue working in pattern until work measures 40.5[43:43:45.5:45.5:48:48]cm (16[17:17:18:18:19:19] ins) or length required from underarm.

Shape raglan

Cast off 1 st at beg. of next 2 rows

Next row: K2, sl1, K1, psso, pattern to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2

Next row: P3, pattern to last 3 sts, P3

Continue decreasing in this way until 62[62:66:66:70:70:70] sts remain ending on a P row.

Shape neck

Next row: Patt 22[22:24:24:26:26:26], turn.

Working on these sts only

Next row: K2tog, pattern to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2

Continue to decrease at armhole edge on every alt as before, dec 1 st at neck edge on every row until 14 sts remain.

Dec at armhole edge only until 3 sts remain

Next row: K3tog
Fasten off.

Slip centre 18 sts onto a holder.
Rejoin yarn to remaining sts, patt to end

Next row: K2, sl1, K1, pssso, patt to last 2 sts, K2tog

Next row: P2tog, patt to end
Continue to decrease at armhole edge on every alt as before, dec 1 st at neck edge on every row until 14[16:16:18:18]sts remain.

Dec at armhole edge only until 3 sts remain

Next row: K3tog
Fasten off

BACK

With 3.25mm knitting needles cast on 110[116:122:128:134:140:146] sts

Work 20 rows K1, P1 rib.

Change to 4mm knitting needles and work in st.st until work measures

40.5[43:43:45.5:45.5:48:48]cm (16[17:17:18:18:19:19] ins) or length required from underarm.

Shape raglan

Cast off 1 st at beg of next 2 rows,

Next row: K2, sl1, K1, pssso, K to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2

Next row: P

Continue decreasing in this way until 34[34:36:36:38:38:38] sts remain. Place sts on holder

SLEEVES

With 3.25mm knitting needles cast on 50[52:52:54:54:56:56] sts and work 19 rows K1, P1 rib
Inc 4 sts evenly on next row.

Change to 4mm knitting needles and commence pattern as follows:

Next row:

K14[15:15:16:16:17:17], P7, K12, P7, K14[15:15:16:16:17:17]

Next row:

P14[15:15:16:16:17:17], K7, P12, K7, P14[15:15:16:16:17:17]

This sets position of pattern panel.

Continue working in pattern increasing 1 st at each end of every 8th row to 80 [84, 84, 88, 88, 92, 92] sts.

Continue working straight until sleeve measures 18 [18, 19, 19, 19, 20, 20] ins or length required

Shape raglan

Cast off 1 st at beg of next 2 rows

Next row: K2, sl1, K1, pssso, patt to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2

Work 3 rows straight

Repeat last 4 rows 4 times

Next row: K2, sl1, K1, pssso, patt to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2

Next row: P3 tog, patt to last 3 sts, P3

Repeat the last 2 rows until 8[8:10:10:12:12:12] sts remain

Leave sts on holder

NECK

K across sts at top of one sleeve, pick up and K

15[15:17:17;18:18:19] sts evenly down left front slope, K across

sts on front holder, pick up and K 15[15:17:17:18:18:19] sts evenly

up right front slope, K across sts on back holder. (98[98:108:108:

116:116:118] sts)

Work 16 rows K1, P1 rib.

Slip sts onto a length of contrasting yarn.

Making up

Join side, sleeve and raglan seams. Fold neckband in half to inside of jumper and slip stitch loosely in place allowing for stretch and taking care to catch every stitch.



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
